- Fully equipped kitchen – 18' by 15'
- Dining room opening from kitchen – 15' by 15'
- Sitting room with open fire and double doors to terrace – 24' by 26'
- Balcony seating area

Whether it is watching a fiery Atlantic sunset, relaxing on the deck as the tides stir the azure waters of Dunmanus Bay below, or taking a stroll on your own private headland and maybe glimpsing a seal diving for fish, Dunmanus House is the perfect place to enjoy the natural beauty of Ireland at its best.

The stone-built house nestles into a hillside on the Mizen Peninsula with panoramic views stretching from headlands and islands to the east, Dunmanus Bay and the Sheep's Head Peninsula to the north, and west towards Mizen Head and the open Atlantic beyond.

Set in 15 acres of open country directly on the coast this is a place to get away from it all, yet restaurants, friendly pubs, sandy beaches, villages, small towns and a host of holiday activities are all close at hand.

With five double bedrooms and an adaptable furnished loft area, Dunmanus House has room for many but the layout makes it a cosy getaway for just two. The house, built in the 1980s, is equipped to a high standard to help you enjoy a comfortable stay.
